The Inverloch Jazz Festival has a long history of bringing the best of jazz to our relaxed seaside town, and from **4 to 6 August 2023** we will be hosting a range of top musicians in our four venues at Inverloch.

The event is brought to life by hundreds of volunteers who act as ushers, ticket sellers, stage crew, technicians and more, who believe 'Jazz is a party and everyone's invited!'

Festival Hosts

The festival started in 1994 with just a few musicians in a single venue, and by 2022 had grown to host more than forty bands and 150 performers across four great venues, who provided an amazing range of jazz.

The event is run by a volunteer committee who offer a range of achievements in music, finance, government, community service, education and technology.

The festival is held in winter, so it gives a healthy boost to local attractions such as gourmet food and wines, accommodation, homewares and apparel outlets, at a time of year when local businesses can use the support.

Festival Structure

A big plus is the festival's location right in the middle of Inverloch itself. Venues are close together and easily walkable.

The halls are accessible, warm and comfortable, some providing snacks and beverages. Most venues are also licenced.

The bands reflect a wide range of jazz genres, with both up-and-coming and well-known musicians who perform over three days.


